Whereas, the annual College Application and Exploration Week serves as a critical initiative aimed at supporting this endeavor; and

Whereas, educators, parents, mentors, and community leaders are given the opportunity to actively engage with students, from elementary to high school, in activities and discussions that foster awareness of postsecondary education and career opportunities.
