Whereas, the West Virginia State Wildlife Center has been a cornerstone of tourism in the region, drawing West Virginians and visitors from far and wide to experience the natural splendor and unique wildlife that our state has to offer, thereby bolstering the local economy and showcasing West Virginia as a premier destination for nature enthusiasts; and

Whereas, the West Virginia State Wildlife Center, and all its staff over the last 100 years, has tirelessly worked towards the rehabilitation and protection of countless animals, further solidifying its position as a beacon of hope for wildlife in our great state; and

Whereas, on September 15 and September 16, we commemorate the 100th Anniversary of the West Virginia State Wildlife Center, recognizing the invaluable contributions it has made to our state and the legacy it leaves for future generations.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim September 15-16, 2023 as:

West Virginia State Wildlife Center 100th Anniversary Days

in the Mountain State and call upon all citizens, schools, community organizations, and businesses to join in the celebration of this remarkable milestone for this incredible institution.
