A PROCLAMATION

By the Governor

WHEREAS, a ban on open burning throughout the State was implemented by Proclamation entered on the November 4, 2024 (the "Burn Ban"); and

WHEREAS, the West Virginia Division of Forestry has reported that the State has received sufficient rainfall at this point to alleviate the need for the Burn Ban to remain in place;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM JUSTICE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of West Virginia, and in view of the foregoing, do hereby **ORDER** that the ban on burning implemented by Proclamation dated November 4, 2024, be **TERMINATED** effective immediately.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
