Proclamation by Governor Jim Justice

Whereas, recognizing the day of March 27, 2024, as "Amniotic Fluid Embolism Awareness Day" to bring needed attention to this devastating and often-fatal pregnancy complication and the importance of reducing maternal mortality resulting from Amniotic Fluid Embolism (AFE) in West Virginia; and

Whereas, according to the Center for Disease Control, the maternal mortality rate for 2021 was 32.9 deaths per 100,000 live births, compared with a rate of 23.8 in 2020 and 20.1 in 2019. Among wealthy nations, the U.S. has the highest rate of maternal mortality; and

Whereas, the maternal mortality rate in West Virginia - (1) 17.3 deaths per 100,000; (2) Though the state reports a figure slightly lower than the national average, much relevant data is missing, making it impossible to fully understand how pervasive the issue is in various communities; and

Whereas, amniotic fluid embolism (AFE) is a leading cause of maternal mortality affecting 2 to 8 per 100,000 births; and

Whereas, an AFE is thought to be the result of an allergic-like reaction to the amniotic fluid or fetal cells that have entered the circulatory system during childbirth, a normal part of the birth process; and

Whereas, AFE Foundation, working in collaboration with key stakeholders in WV, provides meaningful and education and life-saving skills to (1) properly prepare healthcare providers to manage and treat patients; (2) increase lives saved; (3) gain submissions to the AFE Registry and Biorepository; and

Whereas, awareness of AFE and commensurate data collection and research will promote - (1) understanding of this disorder; (2) expanding the search for effective treatment; (3) acceleration of the increased number of lives saved.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *March 27, 2024* as:

Amniotic Fluid Awareness Day

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in this observance.
