Whereas, Chronic Disease Day is supported by the Chronic Disease Alliance and other advocacy organizations dedicated to assisting patients overcome challenges with access to care throughout West Virginia and across the United States; and

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *July 10, 2024* as:

Chronic Disease Day

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in observance.
