Whereas, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority's commitment to change and betterment was demonstrated when its Founders stepped out on faith to march with the suffragettes and took a stand for social

justice as their first public act with their participation in the Women's Suffrage March held on March 3, 1913, for equal and voting rights for women as the only African American

women's organization; and

Whereas, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., is a private, not-for-profit organization, whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities

throughout the world as a public service organization with more than 250,000 members and

more than 1,000 collegiate and alumnae chapters; and

Whereas, in realizing the mission of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, the Bluefield Alumnae and Beta Pi Chapters have organized an extensive array of public service initiatives that

align with the organization's Five-Point Programmatic Thrust of: Economic Development, Educational Development, International Awareness and Involvement, Physical and Mental

Health, and Political Awareness and Involvement; and

Whereas, the Bluefield Alumnae and Beta Pi Chapters of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., are the host
